Our Congregation has set out in a new endeavor. We are actively going to take part in a united effort among the Orthodox Congregations of Cincinnati to merge our resources for better and larger activities. These will encompass three areas:

1. In the area of Youth Activities - By the time you will read this bulletin our Synagogue will have co-hosted a Leadership Shabbaton of the National Conference of Synagogue Youth over the Labor Day Weekend.

2. Adult Education - On Wednesday, October 27, 1971, Rabbi Mordecai Gifter, Rosh Hayishivah and Dean of the famous Telshe Yeshivah will give the opening lecture of the First Semester. The first semester of studies will run from Wednesday, October 27, 1971 through Wednesday, December 1, 1971. The Second Semester will run from Wednesday, April 12, 1972 through Wednesday, May 17, 1972. Each semester will contain five sessions. A brochure of courses will be mailed to you very soon.

3. Campus Activities - We will attempt to supply housing and hospitality for Yom Kippur for students on college campuses. We also invite all out-of-town students to worship with us.
