As you will notice, in reading the constitution, the method of officer nominating has been completely revised from that of past years. Any Hillel member, who feels himself qualified for an office, may petition for it. Petitions require 10 signatures of voting members and that of Dr. Robert Kirsner, our faculty advisor. Dr. Kirsner may be found in 347 McMicken Hall. Petitions are available now at the Hillel house, and are due, Friday, February 4. Elections will be held February 14, 15, 16.

Committee chairmanships for Religious, Publicity, Social and Culture are also open. These petitions are available Monday, Jan. 31 and are due Friday, Feb. 18. Five signatures of students and that of Dr. Kirsner are needed.
