

Additional Remarks to Our Laws of TAHARA

After the Oraun has been properly prepared with Tallis, bedspread and belt, as well as the sack with earth as pillow under the spread, lay out the shrouds in such an order that later on it will not be necessary to search for one or the other.

Prepare a scissors, comb and brush, nailfile and any other tools needed.

Before beginning of washing, do not forget the prayer (on a card at Weil's prepared by Mr. Wasserhart.)

After the body is carefully cleaned comes the actual Tahara. All the water prepared for the washing must be used.

After the cap and trousers have been put on, place the shirt in the opposite direction (c.e. breast upon breast, with the collar opening upon the knees). Reach then (from both sides at the same time) with the hand through the sleeves; take the hand of the deceased and pull through the sleeve. Then it will be easy to pull the back part of the shirt over the head. The same procedure should be followed with the Sargenes.
